- What guidance would you give other organisations who might want to replicate your approach in their organisation
- Upload a sample of photographs you took while completing the project you have described (Optional)

Guideline on saving any Photographs, files for your showcase project submission

- You should use a camera that will produce a photograph in as high a resolution as possible (**when saved the original photograph should be more than 2MB in size**).
- Save a copy of the photograph in its original format before any editing takes place.
- The photographs you enter can capture the planning and running of your project
